Council Chamber

(8.5m/27ft x 8.5m/27ft) 72sq.m and is ideal for formal gatherings.



Blue Room

(5.9m/19ft x 4.1m/13ft) 24sq.m. and is ideal for small meetings.



Green Room (5.9m x 3.5m)
(5.9m/19ft x 3.5m/11ft) 20sq.m. and is ideal for small meetings and training events.



Red Room (5.9m x 3.5m)
(5.9m/19ft x 3.5m/11ft) 20sq.m. and is ideal for small meetings and training events.



Plum Room (4.5m x 2.8m)
(4.5m/14ft x 2.8m/9ft) 12sq.m. This room is suitable for consultations, small groups, 1to1 meetings or lone working.



Main Hall

(19.3m/63ft x 12.2m/40ft) 235sq.m. Our main hall boasts a high ceiling, stage, PA system, bar and kitchen area. This room is suitable for wedding receptions, children's parties, theatrical productions, sporting events and fairs and much more! It has a maximum occupancy of 250.
